<p>The School will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Provide a clean environment and safe routines for students in school, though we accept there can be no guarantees • Make action plans and risk assessments available to parents; • Adhere to the social distancing rules as set out by the government as much as is reasonably practicable; • Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of your child, including their mental health and well-being; • Contact parents/carers immediately if your child displays symptoms of COVID-19; • Inform you if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 in school and issue further guidance on what you and your child must do next; • Continue our clear and consistent positive Behaviour Policy and support the behaviour of children as far as we are able; • Reinforce the schools basic expectations Punctual, Respectful and Safe • Follow the Warn (P-), Move (R-) and Remove (S-) classroom behaviour system to minimise disruption and create a positive learning environment for all. • Support your child's additional needs as far as we are able; • Communicate with parents by text, email, newsletters and the school website. 	<p>To help my child at school, I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check my child for symptoms each morning including checking their temperature; • Not send my child to school if they, or anyone in my household, shows symptoms of COVID-19 - we will get tested and self isolate as a family until the results are received. I will let the school know the results immediately via telephone; • Collect my child from school immediately if they show symptoms of COVID-19; • Remind my child about social distancing rules walking to school and adhere to the timings of the school day if dropping off and picking up; • Remind my child about social distancing rules and the need for frequent hand washing; • Inform the school immediately of any changes to parents/carers emergency contacts details; • Communicate with the school through telephone and email – not through direct contact with staff or the school reception; • Collect my child from school if their behaviour is deemed to be unsafe and attend a meeting before your child is invited back into school. 	<p>I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be Punctual to all tutorials and lessons • Be Respectful at all times to staff and students • Be Safe at all times, following the routines to create a calm and safe environment • Follow the Warn (P-), Move (R-) and Remove (S-) classroom behaviour system. Any removals may result in being sent home • Be sent home for poor behaviour and will only be invited back when staff consider it is safe to do so • Follow social distancing rules on the way to and from school, in classrooms, social areas and around the school; • Tell an adult if I feel unwell; • Bring in my own equipment including pens, pencils, calculators, Chromebook etc. and not share my equipment with others; • Catch coughs and sneezes into a tissue or elbow (catch it, bin it, kill it) and avoiding touching your mouth, nose and hands; • Wash my hands frequently – use soap and water for 20 seconds; • Wait my turn to use the toilet / wash hand basins
