Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of the new Personal, Social and Health Education programme at Princes Risborough School, and in line with our recent RSE consultation, on **Wednesday 6th April**, your child will participate in a series of bespoke lessons along the theme of Responsible Relationships. The topics that will be covered are:

- **Pornography**
- **Sex and Boundaries**
- **Sexual Health and Hygiene (which includes a video condom demonstration)**
- **Diversity, Inclusion and Tolerance**

The sessions will provide knowledge and understanding of safe and healthy relationships based on love and respect, with the ultimate aim of developing safe and healthy relationships in later life. This is also a statutory requirement of the National Curriculum. All sessions are run with sensitivity to people's beliefs and inclusive language is used.

At Princes Risborough School we encourage our students to discuss what they study in PSHE with parents and guardians. On **Thursday 7th April 2022**, there is an opportunity to meet the facilitators, find what your children have been discussing in the workshops and talk about with the how best to approach Sex and Relationships with your child.

We very much hope that your child will learn valuable information through their participation. However, as the parent/guardian of your child, you are entitled to request that your child opts out from sessions where the focus is on sexual education which in this case is session 3.
