PRS Reporting Attainment & Progress in Year 13 2025-26

Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

As you are aware Schools across the Insignis Academy Trust have moved to using a platform called **Pupil Progress** which we hope will provide much more detailed information at each Assessment Point.

Students, parents and carers will need to download an App in order to see their most recent report. Please do this if you have not already done so. Here is a link to a video that explains exactly what you will be able to see in the Pupil Progress App and how to access your reports: [Pupil Progress App - A Guide for Parents, Carers & Students](#)

What will you see in the report?

1) **Summary report** of all subjects which includes 1) Mock Grades, 2) Teacher Predicted Grades, 3) Minimum Target grades (in A Level Subjects, 4) Average Unit Grades, 5) Learning Characteristic grades, with any concerns about homework or attendance.

2) A detailed **Subject report** which shows recent attainment. This is a new addition which will show a detailed breakdown of students' attainment in assessments.

Please note that BTEC courses assess in a different way and will be able to provide more detail later in the year. At the moment for BTEC courses there will not be a Mock grade for all subjects.

Due to unforeseen circumstances English Literature, English Language, Film Studies, Art and Photography will release their mock grades in January. Please accept our apologies for this delay.

What next?

In order for students or parents to set up their accounts, they first need to have **downloaded the app** from the Apple App Store for iPhones, or the Google Play Store for Android phones.

You will also receive an email invitation generated by Pupil Progress from the school. Once you are in the App you should be able to see the most recent report (November 2025).

Something to note:

- You will need to open the invitation email **on the phone you have already installed the App on**, and tap the link in the email to activate your account.

We have also sent a copy of what you will see in the App with this letter via Arbor in case you prefer to use this rather than the App.
