PRS Reporting Teacher Prediction grades 2026 (AP2) Year 10 & 12

Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

We are pleased to let you know that the latest Subject Data information is now available to view. You should see information for all subjects.

Please note that many BTEC subjects in both Year 10 and Year 12 are awaiting results of January components & units, so will not be able to provide the most up to date information. In Year 10 Core PE and PSHE do not report attainment as they do not sit a formal qualification.

As a reminder, here are the instructions that we issued back in December 2024 regarding access to the Pupil Progress App and updated for July & November 2025.

The report is also published in Arbor, under Reports, should you prefer to access the information this way.

Students, parents and carers can download an App in order to see their most recent report.

What will you see in the report in February 2026?

Summary report of all subjects

- Average Unit Grade across the year
- Attitude to Learning and any concerns about homework or attendance
- Teacher Predicted grade for summer 2027.

What next?

*In order for students or parents to set up their accounts, they first need to have **downloaded the app** from the Apple App Store for iPhones, or the Google Play Store for Android phones.*

- You will need to open the invitation email **on the phone you have already installed the App on**, and tap the link in the email to activate your account.
