Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that all Year 10 students will be taking part in a **University Takeover Day** at PRS on **Monday 13th July**, delivered in partnership with **Buckinghamshire New University (BNU)**.

The purpose of the day is to give students an insight into higher education and help them begin to think about their future education and career pathways. The day will begin with a whole-year assembly led by representatives from BNU, who will discuss:

- What university is and how it works
- The benefits of higher education
- Different routes into university
- Student life and opportunities beyond the classroom

Following the assembly, students will attend **four taster lectures** delivered by university staff. These sessions are designed to provide a flavour of studying different subjects at university level and to encourage students to explore areas of interest they may not have previously considered.
