PRS Reporting Attainment & Progress in Year 10 2025-26

Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

Reporting Year 10 attainment in assessments, and overall progress will look different to Key Stage 3. Schools across the Insignis Academy Trust have moved to using a platform called **Pupil Progress** which we hope will provide much more detailed information at each Assessment Point.

As mentioned last year, students, parents and carers will need to download an App in order to see their most recent report. Please do this if you have not already done so.

What will you see in the report?

1. **Summary report** of all subjects which includes 1) Minimum Target grades, 2) Average Unit Grades, 3) Teacher Predicted grade (for summer 2026 only not in November 2025), 4) Learning Characteristic grades, with any concerns about homework or attendance.
2. A detailed **Subject report** which shows recent attainment. This is a new addition which will show a detailed breakdown of students' attainment in assessments.

Please remember that at this early stage of Key Stage 4 courses there may not be lots of assessment; this will depend on the courses. This is a very early snap shot of pupil attainment.

Please note that some BTEC courses assess in a different way and will be able to provide more detail later in the year. At the moment for BTEC courses there may only be a Minimum Target grade and a Learning Characteristic grade.

For this data point you will see a report for English Literature only; we will report both Language and Literature in the summer.

PSHE does not report attainment grades as this is a non GCSE subject.



What next?

In order for students or parents to set up their accounts, they first need to have **downloaded the app** from the Apple App Store for iPhones, or the Google Play Store for Android phones.

You will also receive an email invitation generated by Pupil Progress from the school. Once you are in the App you should be able to see the most recent report (November 2025).

Something to note:

- You will need to open the invitation email **on the phone you have already installed the App on**, and tap the link in the email to activate your account.

We really hope you find this new system more informative than previous reports.

We have also sent a copy of what you will see in the App with this letter via Arbor in case you prefer to use this rather than the App.

As always, once you have read your child's report, if there are queries, please contact the subject teacher in the first instance, or the Head of Year for more general information. I am also happy to answer questions.
