## PRS Reporting Attainment & Progress in Year 11 2025-26

Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

I am writing to let you know that your most recent report is ready to view.

As you are aware, schools across the Insignis Academy Trust have moved to using a platform called **Pupil Progress** which will provide much more detailed information at each Assessment Point.

Students, parents and carers will need to download an App in order to see their most recent report.

### What will you see in the report?

1. **Summary report** of all subjects:

- Minimum Target Grade
- Average Unit Grade (= Mock result)
- Attitude to Learning and any concerns about homework or attendance
- Teacher Predicted grade for summer 2026

2. A detailed **Subject report** which shows attainment and a breakdown of students' attainment in assessments.

Please note, PSHE does not report attainment grades as this is a non GCSE subject.

### What next?

In order for students or parents to set up their accounts, they first need to have **downloaded the app** from the Apple App Store for iPhones, or the Google Play Store for Android phones. We invited you to complete this step last year, but if this didn't happen or if you are new to the school, please follow these steps.

You will have also received an email invitation generated by Pupil Progress from the school. Once you are in the App you should be able to see the most recent report (December 2025).

### Something to note:

- You will need to open the invitation email **on the phone you have already installed the App on**, and tap the link in the email to activate your account.

*We have also sent a copy of what you will see in the App with this letter via Arbor in case you prefer to use this rather than the App.*
