PRS Reporting Attainment & Progress in Year 11 2025-26 AP2 & Mock Results from February 2026

Dear Students, Parents & Carers,

I am writing to let you know that your most recent report is ready to view.

As you are aware, schools across the Insignis Academy Trust have moved to using a platform called **Pupil Progress**. Students, parents and carers will need to download an App in order to see their most recent report.

What will you see in the report?

Summary report of all subjects:

- Minimum Target Grade
- Average Unit Grade (= February Mock result)
- Attitude to Learning and any concerns about homework or attendance
- Teacher Predicted grade for summer 2026

Not every subject completed Mock Exams in February. Please note that due to the English Language Mocks being sent back for re-marks, we have not released these mock results yet. We have, however, provided all the other data for English Language.

Please note, PSHE & Core PE do not report attainment grades as these are non-GCSE subjects.

What next?

In order for students or parents to set up their accounts, they first need to have **downloaded the app** from the Apple App Store for iPhones, or the Google Play Store for Android phones. We invited you to complete this step last academic year and in December 2025, but if this didn't happen or if you are new to the school, please follow these steps.

You will have also received an email invitation generated by Pupil Progress from the school. Once you are in the App you should be able to see the most recent report (March 2026). - You will need to open the invitation email **on the phone you have already installed the App on**, and tap the link in the email to activate your account.
