Your Uniform & Equipment Checklist

Your uniform is a key part of your **school identity** and gives you a strong **sense of belonging**. We are incredibly proud of how smart you look, and we want to keep that up!

Item	The Rule (Please Check Over the Break!)	Why it Matters to You
School Shoes	Plain black, sensible leather shoes (no logos, no high heels, no boots, no canvas/trainer styles).	Having the right shoes means you are comfortable and ready to be in school without having to miss any lessons due to uniform checks.
Nails & Make-Up	No false nails or nail varnish.	Please remove any false nails <i>before</i> term starts to avoid conflict and loss of learning time
Piercings	Only one plain stud in the ear lobe is permitted. All other piercings (multiple ear, nose, body) must be removed.	Do not get new piercings over the break that will need to be taken out—this can be painful and lead to issues when you return.
Hoodies	Hoodies must not be brought into school. They cannot be worn as a substitute for a coat.	Your blazer, a V-neck black jumper, and a coat are all you need to be warm. Hoodies will be confiscated at the gates, and we don't want you to be cold while we sort it out.
Blazers	Your blazer is a compulsory part of your uniform and must be brought to school every day.	Wear your blazer with pride! It's part of the professional standard we set for all our students.
Chromebooks	Please charge your Chromebook fully every evening .	Being charged means you are ready for every lesson. Don't waste time looking for a charger when you should be learning!



Please ensure you return from Easter break in the correct uniform to avoid being removed from circulation.
