When you have made your appointment you will receive an email confirming the time. Appointments are made on a 'first come, first served basis'. There is a facility to request a call or email for a discussion or written feedback should you be unable to book an appointment with your child(s) teacher.

Parents of SEND Students in Year 11 have the opportunity to make an appointment with Ms Geddes to discuss progress or support for the academic year. This is an optional appointment, as you will have contact with the SEND team throughout the year.
