Year 11 Update

Dear Year 11 Students, Parents and Carers,

We will be sending out the latest Year 11 report at the end of this week which will report mock results (where taken), Teacher Predictions for the summer exams and Attitude to Learning grades. We are very proud of the way the students conducted themselves during the exams and we look forward to sharing their successes in these reports.

We have been slightly delayed in this process by an issue that has arisen with the *English Language Mock exams* which were sent off for external marking. The English team have queried the accuracy of the marking on this occasion and as a result we have asked for some of the papers to be re-marked. This process could take some time, but in the mean time we have decided to send out the English Language grades with the reports but we want you to be aware that some grades may eventually go up, and, in a few cases, some may go down. In general, we have noticed that grades have been lower than we might expect. If your child is likely to be affected by this, we will discuss this with you at Year 11 Progress Evening.

On Thursday, students will receive their English Literature results which have been marked internally. For both English Language and English Literature, we are confident that teacher predictions are as accurate as possible, notwithstanding the issues with the English Language marking.
