We believe that our students should look smart and professional. They will take pride in their appearance and in their school. Wearing of the uniform will be enforced and we ask parents for their complete support.

The list below is intended to help parents know what is permitted in school and what is not. If ever parents are in any doubt about items relating to the school dress policy – please telephone and clarify the query before purchasing.

Members of the Sixth Form are not required to wear school uniform but are expected to dress neatly and appropriately for school and with a mind to the example they set for the school as a whole.

A condition of entry to classes at PRS is the correct wearing of full school uniform.

No outer garment, such as a 'hoodie' (including Sports Department Hoodies), should be worn with the uniform. When the weather is cold or wet a suitable plain, dark coloured waterproof jacket should be worn.

Black single breasted blazer with PRS badge on breast pocket. PRS plain green clip on tie.

Black tailored trousers: no low slung' trousers, no exposed zips or rows of buttons, no skinny, skin tight, 'drainpipe' or overly wide trousers, no turn-ups, no denim, chinos or cotton trousers. Plain black belt - no oversize buckles.

From September 2023: Year 7 only - Tartan pleated A line Green and Grey skirt (only available from the School Uniform stores).

Other Year groups: Tartan pleated A line Green and Grey skirt (only available from the School Uniform stores) **or** Plain black skirt no shorter than knee length – Straight or A-line straight skirt. No lycra skirts or similar materials are allowed and should be replaced with the new tartan skirt once worn out. The Tartan skirt will become compulsory uniform for all year 7 – 11 from September 2024.

School shirt: white, either long or short sleeved. Neck size to allow top button to be done up comfortably, no button down collars. Plain white 'T' shirt under shirt (optional).

Black PRS jumper with the school logo. The jumper is optional but it **MUST** come from the uniform supplier.

Black socks with trousers. Black tights or black socks with skirts.

Black formal shoes, no boots, trainers, suede or canvas shoes. Maximum heel height is 4cm. For protection, shoes should cover the top of the foot.

Hair, make up and jewellery Dress Code

Hair should be a presentable style avoiding extremes of fashion or colour. Hair that is dyed or highlighted must look 'natural'. Hair extensions must be natural in colour. No hair 'wraps'. Long hair must be tied back (this is for safety reasons in practical lessons and to encourage eye contact in other lessons). Hair bands/scrunchies must be plain black or green – no other hair decoration is allowed.

Religious headwear, plain black or white.

Make-up is not allowed for students in Yr7-9. Students in Yr10 and Yr11 may wear subtle make-up.

Nail extensions and coloured nail polish are not allowed. Clear nail polish may be worn.

Only one small plain stud allowed in the lobe of each ear. No other piercings allowed.

No jewellery other than a wrist watch. For safety and security no other jewellery should be worn. Charity wrist bands – Only one tight fitting, official charity band is allowed.

PE Uniform

The basic PE kit should be purchased from either from Bucks Schoolwear Plus, Aylesbury or PMG Schoolwear, High Wycombe.

The kit comprises of:

Compulsory items:

Football/Hockey/Rugby Socks (Green/Black)
School logo shorts or 'skort' (Black)
School logo Sports polo-shirt (Green/Black)
Trainers (non-marking soles)

Optional items:

¼ zip logo training top (Black)
School logo Rugby shirt (Green/Black)
School PE leggings or training trousers (Black)
School logo rain jacket (Green/Black)

Certain activities within the school PE curriculum do require students to have with them their own safety equipment; this is often for their own safety but occasionally the safety of others.

Every child in all Year groups will be expected to attend appropriate lessons with:

Football/Rugby boots
Gum shield
Shin pads
Hair band/tie for long hair

Extra items of sportswear can also be purchased from Chiltern Sports in Stoke Mandeville, these include Btec Sport PE kit, Team training and Sports Leaders hoodies. These items can also be worn during PE lessons **but should not be worn in and around school.** We
