

Summer School Princes Risborough School 2021

Between the 23rd and 27th August 2021 Princes Risborough School ran a summer camp which was attended by 146 students, mostly from the future year 7 cohort (who joined us in September 2021)

There were a wide range of activities to support transition to secondary school including:

- meeting teachers
- a tour of the school,
- additional subject support (such as English and maths),
- Sports-based activities,
- Arts-based activities,
- Wellbeing-based activities (such as team building or 'getting-to-know-you' exercises)
- Trip to Whipsnade Zoo

This was provided by a number of people including:

- Qualified teaching staff
- Teaching assistants
- Support staff, for example pastoral or SEND support staff,
- Administrative site and catering staff

The cost of the programme was just under £23k, funded by the Department for Education. This covered the cost of staff (62%), catering for all attendees (18%), activities (6%) and school overheads (13%)
