



Bus Behaviour Contract

Aspire & Achieve

At PRS we expect all students who travel on public transport to and from school to meet the same high standards of behaviour that are required whilst in school. More specifically, students must be sure to:

- Show respect to all individuals on the bus including the driver, other students and members of the public.
- Take any litter off the bus that they have created.
- Remain seated at all times and wear a seat belt where provided.
- Refrain from throwing anything on the bus, or out of the bus.
- Avoid distracting the driver unless in an emergency.
- Use respectful and appropriate language.

Failure to adhere to this contract will result in:

Stage 1 – A letter home and a warning that repeated poor behaviour will lead to Stage 2.

Stage 2 – A fixed-term bus ban.

Stage 3 - A permanent bus ban.

Please note:

- All students are encouraged to report any instances of inappropriate behaviour on the buses to school staff.
- The Police will, on unannounced occasions, travel on buses to monitor behaviour.
- You will be held financially responsible for any damage you have caused.
- If at any point you feel unsafe or concerned about behaviour on the bus, please complete a bus concerns sheet, which is located and handed in at reception.
