**As a student, I will:**

- ✓ Arrive at school every day on time; Come to school regularly. School starts at 8.30am
- ✓ Present myself in school uniform (as described in the School Uniform Policy) and understand that when I am in uniform I am representing the school;
- ✓ Be Punctual and correctly equipped for lessons. 'Ready to learn'
- ✓ Be Respectful - Respond positively to staff on first request
- ✓ Be Safe - walk calmly around the school and keep your hands to yourself. We are a 'hands off' school.
- ✓ Be Successful by working hard to achieve my target grades; Completing homework on time and meeting deadlines
- ✓ Be tolerant and respectful to others and their property
- ✓ Be an ambassador for the school at all times both in and out of school; Strive for the highest standards in all areas of school life and beyond the school gates.
- ✓ Not be a bystander - (We have a zero tolerance approach to all discriminatory behaviour and any form of bullying. Make sure you report any unkind behaviour. This also includes any inappropriate social media use).
- ✓ Look out for my PRS community and be kind.
- ✓ Try a range of extra-curricular activities in and out of school.
- ✓ Honour commitments to take part in activities and practices/rehearsals (e.g. teams, plays, concerts).
- ✓ Support my House and my School to the best of my ability.
- ✓ Understand that poor behaviour and poor attendance will impact on my opportunity to attend school trips, reward days and activities week.

**As a parents or carer I will:**

- ✓ Ensure that my child goes to school regularly, wearing the correct uniform, is on time and correctly equipped. School starts at 8.30am
- ✓ Let the School know about any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour
- ✓ Fully support the School's policies and guidelines for behaviour; Including after school detentions, so there is consistency between home and school.
- ✓ Support my child with homework;
- ✓ Attend Progress Evenings and discussions about my child's progress.
- ✓ Avoid family holidays during term time.
- ✓ Get to know about my child's life at the school.
- ✓ Be responsible for my child's social media usage and monitor this regularly.
- ✓ Understand that appointments with members of staff should be made in advance as they cannot usually be available for meetings without notice
- ✓ Permit the administration of analgesics (paracetamol) to my child if a first-aid trained staff member considers this appropriate.

**As a school, we will:**

- ✓ Praise and reward students who are Positive, Responsible & Successful
- ✓ Contact parents/carers if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or equipment
- ✓ Let parents/carers know about any concerns or problems that affect their child's work or behaviour;
- ✓ Provide a rigorous and balanced curriculum
- ✓ Encourage good behaviour, for example through: Personal, Social, Health Education; Personal Development, the Pastoral System; the Anti-Bullying Policy; praise and recognition of contributions.
- ✓ Plan teaching so that the needs of each child are met.
- ✓ Send home regular reports on each child's progress
- ✓ Set and monitor homework and provide facilities for children to do homework in school;
- ✓ Arrange Progress Evenings during which progress will be discussed
- ✓ Keep parents/carers informed about school activities through regular communication home, newsletters and notices about special events.
